## Feedback analysis on offered courses (2018-19)

#### Policy/ Criteria for Feedback Analysis

- The feedback analysis on courses is performed based on course satisfaction level from the stakeholders (primarily students) which is focussed on both the course components, rationality for the students, its delivery, its transactions and relevant acumens.
- Every student in course feedback answers 5 questions per course from the dropdown list which includes excellent, very good, good, average and poor.
- In the web-based system, the feedback is converted into numeric as follows:

Excellent-5

Very good-4

Good-3

Average-2

Poor-1

- From this conversion, we get a total score and percentage satisfaction level against each course.
- After Collecting the feedback on faculty and course by the students, an online summary and detailed report Is collected both in html and pdf format.
- The Course feedback satisfaction level has been classified as Good (>=80%). Moderate (<80% and >=60%) and poor (<60%) based on feedback core by the respondents.</p>
- The Course attainment has been measured based on result analysis whose metrics have been assigned as:

Attainment 3- 80% or above number of students from that particular batch obtained Grade C (Grade Point 6) or above

Attainment 2- 70-79% of students from that particular batch obtained Grade C (Grade Point 6) or above

  - ✓ How many courses achieved excellent feedback (>= 90%) as well as highest course attainment?



# Distribution of satisfaction level




