### Appellant

She further refused to talk with the accused, in spite of his persistent persuasions or his friends. She was found nervous and cried in front of the committee members. The committee members asked whether the accused not misbehaved with her in any occasion, during the course of time and was that the reason that she her discontinuation with him. She replied that he never misbehaved but as she blocked him, his friend and he persuaded her to talk. She is nervous and do not want to continue further.

#### Accused

On interrogations, the accused seems to agree upon the said part by the appellant. He clarified to have adorations for the appellant and therefore pursued her to clear any misunderstands between them. He further showed all the message exchanged between them.

FRIEND 1 OF ACCUSED: informed the committee members that he was by his side when he asked to friend with the appellant and the appellant happily accepted such friendship.

FRIEND 2 OF ACCUSED: also narrated the same version when called separately and informed the committee members that he and accused friend 1 was by the side of the accused when he proposed to the appellant and the appellant happily accepted such friendship.

FRIEND 3 OF ACCUSED: On request of the accused, the accused friend 3 and FRIEND 4 OF ACCUSED persuaded the appellant to reconcile the appellant to talk to the accused for he is unable to concentrate in his workings.

FRIEND 4 OF ACCUSED: She also accepted that on request of the accused, FRIEND 4 OF ACCUSED persuaded the appellant to reconcile the appellant to talk to the accuser for he is unable to concentrate in his workings.

## Minutes of meeting

After hearing all the narrations and the WhatsApp messages exchanged between them, the committee members decided to check the CCTV footage of library where the incident happens when the accused proposed the appellant for her friendship. From the footage it was clear that some exchange happened and the appellant was found carefree during the incidence. These was also evident in the WhatsApp message exchanged between the two and showed mutual acceptance. However, within two days of such proposal acceptance, the accused was blocked and no reasons for such was neither evident from the interrogations. As the appellant accepted herself on interrogation that the accused did not misbehave with him in any occasion, but did not want to continue any further with him.

The meeting concluded with found following findings

- The appellant and respondent were found sharing thoughts over the WhatsApp messenger for a span of few days.
- The chat shared between them was concealed by the appellant but, was produced by the respondent.



#### NOTICE

With reference to the ICC case no. ICC/2/BCRCP/12-22 dated 9<sup>th</sup> December 2022, the ICC has submitted its report and recommendations after thorough investigation and documentation about the incident.

The respondent against whom the complaint was lodged by the student was found guilty and further he tried to deceive the ICC members by acting innocent, though the facts of the matter came out during the interrogation and investigation with the help of all parties including the witnesses.

Accordingly, as per the recommendations of the committee, the following disciplinary measures are being taken against the respondent Mr. Sandip Pramanick, B. Pharm Ist year:

- 1. Mr. is being suspended from attending the college for 1 month w.e.f 1<sup>st</sup> day of his 2<sup>nd</sup>. Semester.
- 2. He is also debarred from appearing in CA4 examination of 1st Semester.

Further, the following corrective measures are suggested -

- 1. The respondent's parents must be informed about the indecent behavior by his Mentor for counseling at home. When the student rejoins the college after the suspension, he must produce an apology letter countersigned by his parents and submit the same to the ICC.
- 2. The Mentor of the respondent is being made aware of the incident (the details of which can be obtained from ICC) and the Mentor is entrusted with counseling of the Mentee for instilling ethical and moral values, particularly, towards fellow students of opposite sex for an overall professional development of the student. A report on the same should be submitted to the ICC (with a copy to the undersigned) regarding the measures taken by the Mentor and outcome(s) thereof within Two Weeks of the respondent rejoining the college after his suspension period.

The respondent is reminded that in the path to become a successful professional, imbibing high ethical and moral values including respect towards the opposite sex is mandatory. In order to continue study in this institution, he must keep this in mind and should not break the Code of Conduct of the Institution in any form in future.



She briefed that during the practical class her batch mate from other section touched her inappropriately. She felt humiliated and demanded for justice.

On receiving her complaint, ICC called subsequent meetings for interrogations and hearing of narrations by the witnesses, who were present at the site of incident directly or indirectly involved in the matter. After hearing the narrations from the various witnesses, appellant, and the respondent, ICC members found following:

### FINDINGS:

- Respondent was guilty of the act.
- He behaved innocent and deceived the facts

#### **NARRATIONS**

### The appellant (A)

On 29<sup>th</sup> November, Tuesday, the group A of 1<sup>st</sup> year B.pharm missed Pharmaceutical Inorganic practical class, they were therefore allowed to perform the practical with group C on Friday 02<sup>nd</sup> December 2022.

A said that on 02/12/22 during the demonstration of a practical by the teacher in Pharmaceutical Inorganic practical class, year mate of 1<sup>st</sup> year B.pharm, Mr R inappropriately stood by her side with his arms stretched over the waist of her classmate named P and the other arm on her waist. She narrated that she felt that P enjoying this act of R for she kept her head over his shoulder, while she felt uncomfortable and moved side wise to avoid him. However, in spite of moving out from the previous position where she was standing, R followed her so was P along with R. She then felt embarrassed and was forced to changed her place to the opposite side of the position, where others member of group A was standing. The behavior of R and her moving to the opposite side was observed by her classmates (AnS, ArS, AkB).

After hearing the appellant, the ICC members decided to call the classmates who had been aware of the incidence and to record the narrations.

#### AnS

On Tuesday, the group A of 1<sup>st</sup> year B.pharm missed the practical Inorganic class and therefore group C and group A practical was merged on Friday. R from group C was constantly touching the appellant A, in spite of her moving sideways away from him. Conversely, P who stood with R in an inappropriate, way also moved along with him and enjoyed his act. She then advised A to move to the opposite side of the slab, where others fellow mates of the same group A were standing to observe the practical. She said that he even approaches her with the same act, but she narrowed her eyebrows to keep him away with his ideal the proposite side of the slab.

He said he did not see the incident that day but felt that some-thing happened with A, later he got to know from A that R had touched A with ill thoughts.

#### ArS

ArS is one among the group A student who missed the practical class on Tuesday, therefore had joined the group C for Pharmaceutical Inorganic practical. In the practical class, while the demonstration was on, they were standing surrounding the teacher, in one side where the girls (A & AnS) stood, some boys of group C stood behind them. He found A irritated and when A asked them whether she can to join from the opposite side, he and his friend gave her the space to freely stand with them, and later got informed about the incident.

### The respondent: R

When asked about the incident, R was not aware of the incident and rather denied to have behaved in any such way.

P

P was also called for her narration about the incident. She said that nothing happened.



#### NOTICE

- 2. He is also debarred from appearing in CA4 examination of 1st Semester.
