1. Academic (Program) Committee

The B. Pharm. program shall have an Academic (Program) Committee constituted by the Head of t institution.

2. Project work

All the students shall undertake a project under the supervision of a teacher and submit a report. The of the project shall be decided by the supervisor in consultation with the student. The project ma carried out in group not exceeding 3 in number.

The internal and external examiner appointed by the University shall evaluate the project at the time of Practical examinations of other semester(s).

3. Industrial training (Desirable)

Every candidate shall be required to work for at least 150 hours spread over four weeks Pharmaceutical Industry/Hospital. It includes Production unit, Quality Control department, Quasiarance department, Analytical laboratory, Chemical manufacturing unit, Pharmaceutical F Hospital (Clinical Pharmacy), Clinical Research Organization, Community Pharmacy, etc. After Semester – VI and before the commencement of Semester – VII, and shall submit satisfactory reposuch work and certificate duly signed by the authority of training organization to the head of the institu

4. Practice School

In the VII semester, every candidate shall undergo practice school for a period of 150 hours exdistributed throughout the semester. The student shall opt any one of the domains for practice school declared by the academic (program) committee from time to time.

At the end of the practice school, every student shall submit a printed report (in triplicate) on the praschool he/she attended (not more than 25 pages). Along with the exams of semester VII, the r submitted by the student. The knowledge and skills acquired by the student through practice school be evaluated by the subject experts at college level and grade point shall be awarded.
