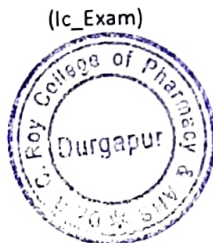

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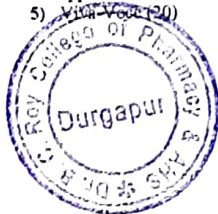



## WHAT IS TRANSDERMAL DRUG DELIVERY SYSTEM(TDDS)?

TDDS is a painless method of delivering drugs systemically by applying a drug formulation onto intact and healthy skin. The drug initially penetrates through the stratum corneum and then passes through the deeper epidermis and dermis without drug accumulation in the dermal layer. When drug reaches the dermal layer, it becomes available for systemic absorption via the dermal microcirculation.

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## ABOUT SKIN

- o Skin is the most accessible and largest organ of the body with a surface area of 1.7 m<sup>2</sup>, comprising 16% of the total body mass of an average person. Skin can be divided into three main regions: (1) the outermost layer, the epidermis, which contains the stratum corneum; (2) the middle layer, the dermis and (3) the inner most layer, the hypodermis .

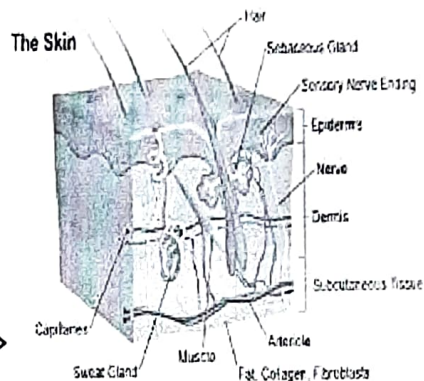


Fig. 2 Anatomy of Skin [8]

## ROUTES OF DRUG PENETRATION

There are two possible routes of drug penetration across the intact skin, namely the transcellular and paracellular pathways, which have been diagrammatically presented in Figure 2.

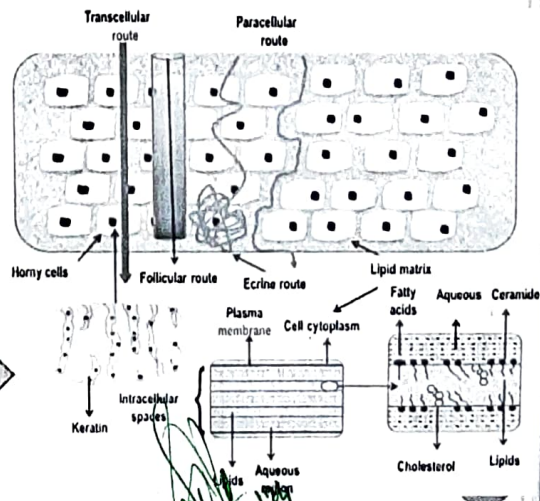


Fig. 3 Routes of drug penetration [8]



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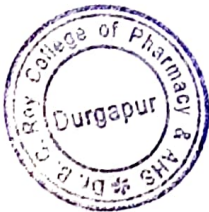
