






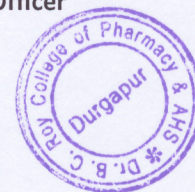
Report for Academic Year 2023-24:

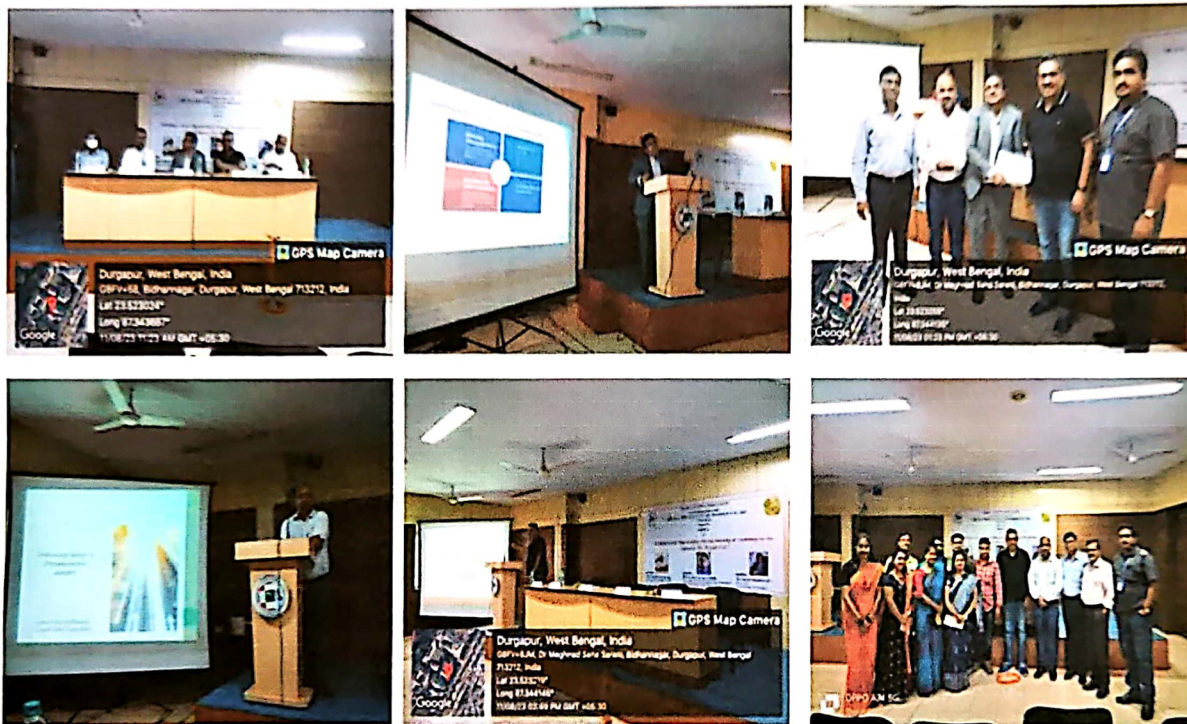

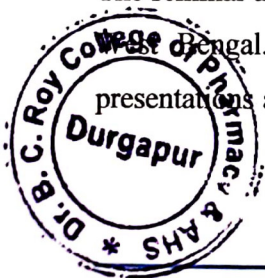

SEMINAR REPORT

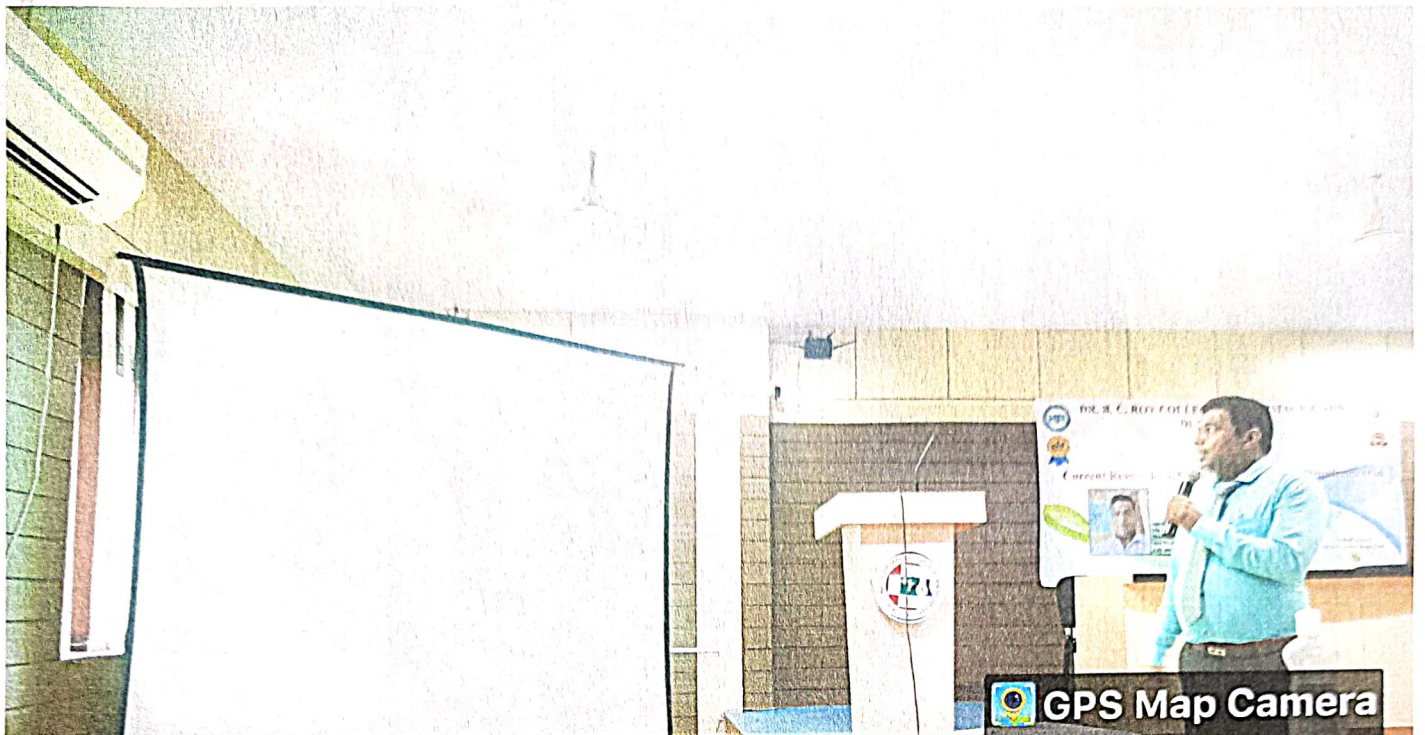
