With the commencement of the academic year 2023-24 and the arrival of new students, the committee increased its anti-ragging measures. To raise awareness, anti-ragging posters and banners were displayed across the campus. The Anti-Ragging Committee and Anti-Ragging Squad, along with the phone numbers of each member, were prominently displayed in various locations across the campus. All students were required to sign anti-ragging declarations upon admission. The college established an Anti-Ragging Squad comprising faculty, staff, and senior students to conduct surprise inspections in the campus, its vicinity, canteen, and hostels. Strict anti-ragging rules were incorporated into the college prospectus. To provide support and guidance to new students, a mentorship program was implemented, pairing each new student with a faculty mentor. These mentors offered counseling and support, addressing any concerns or anxieties students may have experienced. To ensure a safe and secure environment, the college employed one Assistant Proctor, two Wardens, and two Matrons to oversee student welfare in the hostels. Additionally, CCTV surveillance was installed in key areas of the campus and hostels to enhance monitoring.

Fortunately, no ragging incidents were reported during the academic year 2023-24. The committee's proactive approach, combined with the support of faculty, staff, and students, has contributed to maintaining a harmonious and ragging-free campus.
