 M_{\star}^{4} is the mean of marks of top 0.1% or top 10 (whichever is larger) of all the candidates who appeared for the test

 $S_q^q = 350$, is the score assigned to M_q^q $S_t^q = 900$, is the score assigned to M_t^q M_q^q is 25 marks (out of 100) or μ + σ , whichever is greater. Here, μ is the mean and σ is the standard deviation of marks of all the candidates who appeared for the test paper.
