

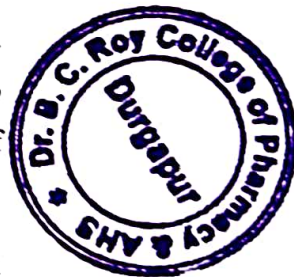


A REPORT ON RABINDRA JAYANTI OBSERVED ON 7th MAY, 2024.

“Hey Nutan, Dekha Dik Aar Bar Jonmer Prothom Subhokhon!!”. On Pochishe Boishakh every year, Tagore’s followers and admirers worldwide mark the day singing the song that celebrates life. Just like the song, set in morning raga Bhairavi, welcomes the dawn and prays for the auspicious moment of birth to return, like the sun rises every day displacing all morning haze and mist, 25 Baishakh marks the beginning of a new era with the birth of Rabindranath Tagore, a novelist, poet, writer, and philosopher. Born to Sarada Devi and Debendranath Tagore on 7th May 1861 in Jorasanko Thakurbai in Kolkata, Tagore is an integral part of the Bengali psyche and omnipresent in the art and culture scene of Bengal. Tagore was a historical pinnacle, after which everything was a kind of a decline. There is no doubt that Tagore remains one of modern India’s finest artists and thinkers and also one of the few Bengali polymaths of the last two centuries.

The faculty, staff, and students of Dr. B.C. Roy College of Pharmacy & Allied Health Sciences also celebrated the auspicious occasion on May 7, 2024, at APC Roy Seminar Hall.
