Report on Seminar

2019-20

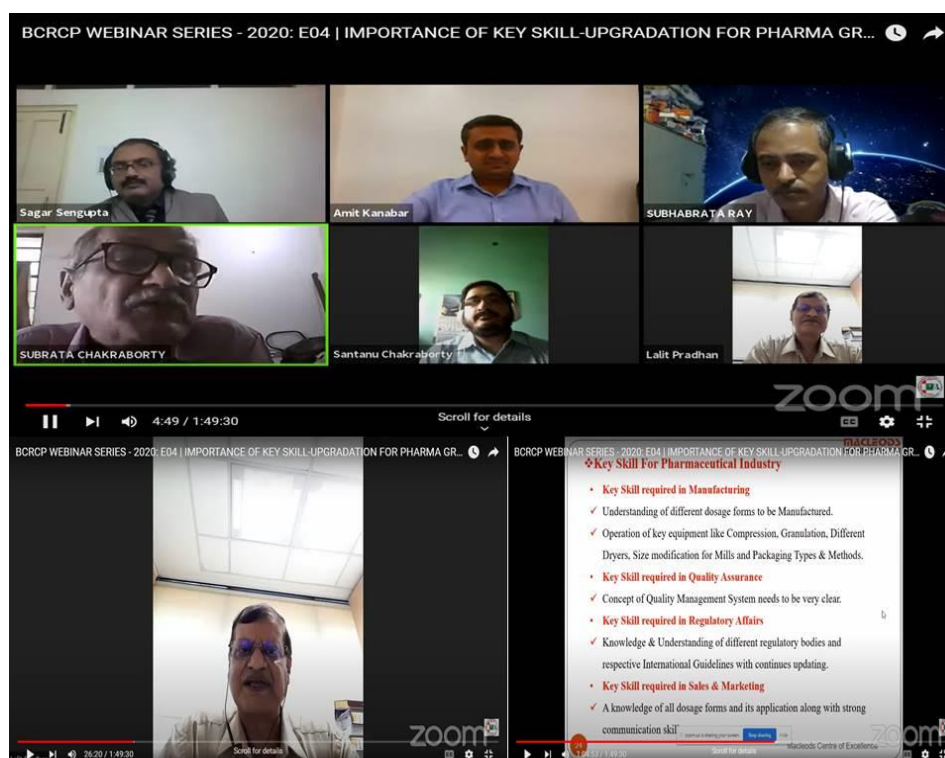
A seminar was organized on 7th August 2019 when Mr. Debabrata Ghosh (Former Assistant Director of Drug Control, Kolkata) presented a topic 'B. Pharm curriculum with relation to relation to various Pharmaceutical jobs'. On the same day, another seminar was organized on the topic 'History of pharmacy education in India' by Mr. Prabir Ghosh. On 7th September 2019, Mr. Kunal Vora (Cofounder and CEO, SHRM Biotechnologies Pvt. Ltd.) delivered a lecture on the topic 'Career in biotechnology and life sciences -prospect & future perspective'. In this seminar, 156 participants were present.

In the year 2020, Dr. B. C. Roy College of Pharmacy and Allied Health Sciences organized four webinars. On 6th June 2020, a webinar was organized on the topic 'Patents in Pharmaceutical Industry' presented by Dr. Praveen Kumar Sharma of Dr. Reddy's Laboratory Ltd. with 1335 participants.

On 13th June 2020, another webinar was organized with the topic 'Management protocol of Covid19: Govt. of West Bengal'. The speaker of the topic was Prof. Suhrita Paul, Principal of Burdwan Medical College, West Bengal. 1224 participants were present in this webinar.

On 20th June 2020, Dr. R. S. Thakur (Dean, Ranchi College of Pharmacy) was the speaker of the webinar ‘Opportunities for Indian Pharmaceutical Industries in the Aftermath of Covid19’ in which 930 participants were enrolled.





With 738 participants, a webinar named 'Importance of key skill upgradation in the post pandemic world of pharmaceutical industry' was organized on 27th June 2020. The speakers of the webinar were Mr. Lalit Pradhan (Head of Technical Training, Macleods Pharmaceutical Ltd.) and Mr. Amit Kanabar (Head, Macleods Centre of Excellence, Macleods Pharmaceutical Limited).
