- c) Brief narration of the incident: The girl student was constantly disturbed over phone by one faculty (male).
- d) Detailed narration of the incident: This incident mainly has happened during their 8th semester.
- e) Date-wise proceedings of the enquiry: I, Dr. Kajal Ghosal met the student on 10th may at 4 pm in her hostel. (As they don't have any classes or examination)
- f) Facts that emerge from the enquiry: Presently, the student does not want to lodge any complaint against the faculty.
- g) Misconduct under the provisions of specific clauses of Indian Standing Orders Act i) Recommendations on organisational changes: We have not got any written complaint. But as the safety of our student is involved here, I have been instructed by Registrar of our College to look after the matter.

Dear Sir,

- 1) The accused student Sk. Nadim Ali, of 2nd year section A, should be sent for medical recourse for rehabilitation to any government hospital as he is found to be drug addicted. After coming back, he will report to the principal with medical fit certificate and one apology letter stating that he will not repeat that misbehavior with any of his classmates.
- 2) During his suspension period once he should come along with his guardian to report to the principal regarding their course of action in getting the medical treatment.
- 3) He needs career long counseling and he should report to the principal throughout his B Pharm course.
- 4) Transferring him from section A to section B to assure the victim about her safety.
- 5) It is also recommended that his mentor may observe his day to day active after rejoining
- 6) Further repetition of this type of activity will be considered on a serious note.

But Nadim doesn't stop disturbing them and he was constantly disturbing Zinat by repeatedly saying sorry (5 to 6 times). In canteen also, Nadim followed them and again he created nulsance there. He dipped one of his hands into the sauce over their plate. They left the plate and come upstairs. There also Nadim followed them and tried to say sorry to Zinataman in a bad way. He bent down and tied to reach Zinataman's skirt.

ZINATAMAN'S NARRATION

According to Zinataman Sarkar's narration, last Friday on 13th July 2018 she was in her microbiology practical class. She noticed that in that Nadim entered into the class 1 hour late. It seemed that he was ill.

Just after entering the class he started to stare at her, which was not felt good by Zinataman. Then he started singing song, first she ignored all these things but suddenly Nadim called her and when she looked at him, he winked. Zinataman strictly warned him and said that this should not repeat any more.

Immediately after hearing this he apolozised and said sorry, but started to say the word "sorry" repeatedly. Zinataman felt that he was just creating a scene in front of everybody in the class.

After the practical class was over in the recess, Zinataman and her friend Shuvechha went to canteen for refreshment, Nadim followed her in the canteen and there also he said sorry but not in a good way.

His activity was showing that either he was drunk or had taken some drugs. Through all his activity it was showing that he was not in his sense. After that it was came to know that he really had taken drugs (clonezapam). Then again when she and Shuvechha went to the place where the water filter is kept there he constantly started to gaze at her. He came near to them and it seemed he tried to catch her hand, they shouted then he went away. Through all these behavior of Nadim, Zinataman was feeling very unsafe.

Then Zinataman felt that since morning she was tolerating all those nonsense activites of Nadim, now it was beyond her tolerance level and she decided to lodge a complaint against Nadim.

She lodged her complaint against Nadim by giving a written application to the Principal and pleaded for decision of the college authorities.

Following is my submission in the recent case under trial of ICC, BCRCP -

Being the additional class-teacher of second year, I was called upon by the Principal, BCRCP in absence of Ms. Pooja Mishra, Class teacher, second year, Sec-A, on 13th of July 2018 (Friday), at around 4.30 pm regarding an incidence of misbehaviour and harassment in the same class. It was brought to my notice through the Principal, BCRCP that a female student of second year, Ms. Zinataman Sarkar, faced harassment by classmate Sk Nadim Ali on the basis of a written complaint submitted by the same. It was also reported by the girl that the boy was in an intoxicated state during the class hours. In this regard, the student in question Sk Nadim Ali was called upon and was questioned infront of the Registrar, BCRCP, Mr Sagar Sengupta on the same day.

Upon questioning, Sk Nadim Ali mentioned that he was carrying a Clonazepam 1mg tablet strip with evidence of 2 consumed tablets in his pocket. He also accepted to have misbehaved with the girl. Thenafter, the strip of medicine was confiscated by the undersigned and Sk Nadim Ali was asked to leave the campus.

Please note that Sk Nadim finally confessed that he was a habitual addict of all sorts in the past and trying to come out of that situation.

However, he admitted his mistake and also stated that he shall not repeat such behaviour in future.

After thorough inquiry, it was revealed that Sk Nadim Ali was carrying a Clonazepam 1mg tablet strip with evidence of 2 consumed tablets in his pocket. The strip was immediatedly confiscated by the undersigned and Sk Nadim Ali was asked to leave the campus immediately thereafter.

To hinder his misdoing, he tried to bring forward fever as the reason of carrying such drug and mentioned Aftab Khan's (B. Pharm 3rd year student) name who advised him to take clonazepam, which was found totally false later on.

Sk Nadim finally confessed that he was a habitual addict of all sorts in the past and trying to come out of that situation.

He stated that he shall not repeat his mistake.

4. Mr. Sagar Sengupta have contacted him. He will be present on Friday (20th July, 2018).

- 5. Mr. Sagar Sengupta has suggested to issue a notice to make all stake holders to be aware of the role of ICC.
- 6. It has been suggested by members to record victim's complaint, other eyewitnesses' complaint as well as if accused do like to let something to be recorded. Also class teacher's note (Mrs. Rituparna Chaki Ghosh) and Mr. Sagar Sengupta note regarding this incident (as initially they listen to the incident from complainant and accused as well) have to be collected and all these reports will be used for further investigation.
- 7. One e-mail address has to be formulated for further communication for all related persons related with this issue.

Meeting adjourned at 3:15 pm. Next meeting is called on 20th July, 2018.

She heard them to comment on the wear. She found the remarks to be extremely derogative and ashamed to speak the same. She also assumed that the remarks were indicative to S K Meheronnisha as she was sitting visibly opposite to the group of boys. She therefore asked S K Meheronnisha to move away from the chair.


