Sub.: Decision against the forwarded written complaint on 13th July 2018 by [REDACTED]

Dear Sir,

The following decisions have been taken by ICC members against the complaint lodged by Ms. [REDACTED] as the nature of misbehavior was ^{found to be} gender biased ,

- 1) The accused student [REDACTED], of 2nd year section A, should be sent for medical recourse for rehabilitation to any government hospital as he is found to be drug addicted. After coming back, he will report to the principal with medical fit certificate and one apology letter stating that he will not repeat that misbehavior with any of his classmates.
- 2) During his suspension period once he should come along with his guardian to report to the principal regarding their course of action in getting the medical treatment.
- 3) He needs career long counseling and he should report to the principal throughout his B Pharm course.
- 4) Transferring him from section A to section B to assure the victim about her safety.
- 5) It is also recommended that his mentor may observe his day to day active after rejoining the classes
- 6) Further repetition of this type of activity will be considered on a serious note.

Narrations by [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] was called upon and his statements were recorded. As per the record, he stated that he attended the college at 10:00 o' clock and went to microbiology lab. Recess resumed at 1: 30 and had his lunch at canteen, moved out of the college to smoke and consumed two tablets of clonazepam and went back to attend the classes. He was fast asleep, and only got to answer his attendance call by Mr Avik Saha, after his friends woke up. He then failed to recall when exactly the incidence took place whether in the succeeding period or in a break after the class. He confessed that he did tease the girl [REDACTED] because she turned back and many a times to observed the time within a period of 10 min. He felt guilty of the incidence and repented on doing the things again and again.

He further confesses that he is addicted to drugs. He regularly consumes ganja; and because he was facing some difficulties, he wanted to change to some other drugs. So he asked his friend [REDACTED] for help. He went to his friend [REDACTED] where [REDACTED] helped him with four strips of clonazepam. The committee member asked the source of such drugs as it is difficult to buy the same from the medicine shop. He explained that such drugs were procured by [REDACTED], whose father is a Doctor.

[REDACTED] was absent on 25.07.18, so collection of signature was not possible - Kajal Ghosal (25/07/18)

narration: In absence of teacher, [redacted] was calling [redacted]'s name from back. [redacted] and [redacted] both looked back and at that time, [redacted] gave a bad expression closing his one eye. [redacted] scolded [redacted] asking why he is doing that or is he drunk? But [redacted] doesn't stop disturbing them and he was constantly disturbing [redacted] by repeatedly saying sorry (5 to 6 times). In canteen also, [redacted] followed them and again he created nuisance there. He dipped one of his hands into the sauce over their plate. They left the plate and come upstairs. There also [redacted] followed them and tried to say sorry to [redacted] in a bad way. He bent down and tried to reach [redacted] skirt.

According to [REDACTED]'s narration, last Friday on 13th July 2018 she was in her microbiology practical class. She noticed that in that [REDACTED] entered into the class 1 hour late. It seemed that he was ill.

Just after entering the class he started to stare at her, which was not felt good by [REDACTED]. Then he started singing song, first she ignored all these things but suddenly [REDACTED] called her and when she looked at him, he winked. [REDACTED] strictly warned him and said that this should not repeat any more.

Immediately after hearing this he apologized and said sorry, but started to say the word "sorry" repeatedly. [REDACTED] felt that he was just creating a scene in front of everybody in the class.

After the practical class was over in the recess, [REDACTED] and her friend [REDACTED] went to canteen for refreshment, [REDACTED] followed her in the canteen and there also he said sorry but not in a good way.

His activity was showing that either he was drunk or had taken some drugs. Through all his activity it was showing that he was not in his sense. After that it was came to know that he really had taken drugs (clonazepam). Then again when she and [REDACTED] went to the place where the water filter is kept there he constantly started to gaze at her. He came near to them and it seemed he tried to catch her hand, they shouted then he went away. Through all these behavior of [REDACTED] was feeling very unsafe.

Then [REDACTED] felt that since morning she was tolerating all those nonsense activities of [REDACTED], now it was beyond her tolerance level and she decided to lodge a complaint against Nadim.

She lodged her complaint against [REDACTED] by giving a written application to the Principal and pleaded for decision of the college authorities.

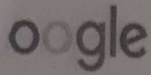

Following is my submission in the recent case under trial of ICC, BCRCP –

Being the additional class-teacher of second year, I was called upon by the Principal, BCRCP in absence of Ms. Pooja Mishra, Class teacher, second year, Sec-A, on 13th of July 2018 (Friday), at around 4.30 pm regarding an incidence of misbehaviour and harassment in the same class. It was brought to my notice through the Principal, BCRCP that a female student of second year, Ms. [REDACTED] faced harassment by classmate [REDACTED] on the basis of a written complaint submitted by the same. It was also reported by the girl that the boy was in an intoxicated state during the class hours. In this regard, the student in question [REDACTED] was called upon and was questioned in front of the Registrar, BCRCP, Mr. Sagar Sengupta on the same day.

Upon questioning, [REDACTED] mentioned that he was carrying a Clonazepam 1mg tablet strip with evidence of 2 consumed tablets in his pocket. He also accepted to have misbehaved with the girl. Thereafter, the strip of medicine was confiscated by the undersigned and [REDACTED] was asked to leave the campus.

Please note that [REDACTED] finally confessed that he was a habitual addict of all sorts in the past and trying to come out of that situation. However, he admitted his mistake and also stated that he shall not repeat such behaviour in future.

On 13th of July 2018 (Friday), in the afternoon at around 4.30 pm Ms. Rituparna Chaki Ghosh, Class teacher of B. Pharm 2nd Year Section A, asked me to be present during a talk with [REDACTED], a student of her section.

She informed me about a complaint, forwarded by the Principal, BCRCP, against [REDACTED]

I asked Ms. RCG and [REDACTED] to come to the my chamber.

The complaint was basically of a misbehavior (supposedly of gender harrasment) in an intoxicated state.

After thorough inquiry, it was revealed that [REDACTED] was carrying a Clonazepam 1mg tablet strip with evidence of 2 consumed tablets in his pocket. The strip was immediatedly confiscated by the undersigned and [REDACTED] was asked to leave the campus immediately thereafter.


To hinder his misdoing, he tried to bring forward fever as the reason of carrying such drug and mentioned [REDACTED] (B. Pharm 3rd year student) name who advised him to take clonazepam, which was found totally false later on.

[REDACTED] finally confessed that he was a habitual addict of all sorts in the past and trying to come out of that situation.

He stated that he shall not repeat his mistake.

A written complaint was lodged by one of our student [REDACTED] (Roll No: 2, Sec-A, 2nd yr) to Principal, BCRCP against another student, [REDACTED] (Roll No: 1, Sec-A, 2nd yr) on 13th July, 2018. Principal (Dr. subhabrata Ray) and Class teacher of 2nd year (Mrs. Rituparna Chaki Ghosh) forwarded that matter to ICC for further action. So a Meeting was called at 2:45 pm on 17th July, 2018 to investigate the matter comprised of ICC members. Along with the written complaint, another note from [REDACTED] was submitted to ICC stating that a strip of 1 mg clonazepam was confiscated from him.

2. [REDACTED] the complainant was present on that day and she agreed with her written complaint against [REDACTED]. She told that [REDACTED] is constantly disturbing her. [REDACTED] is a little bit scared. She is feeling unsafe. She has blocked all contacts of [REDACTED]. They thought that [REDACTED] is drunk.
3. [REDACTED] (Roll no. [REDACTED]) another student of same section also supported [REDACTED] claim. [REDACTED] was absent on that day.
4. Mr. Sagar Sengupta has contacted him. He will be present on Friday (20th July, 2018).
5. Mr. Sagar Sengupta has suggested to issue a notice to make all stake holders to be aware of the role of ICC.
6. It has been suggested by members to record victim's complaint, other eyewitnesses' complaint as well as if accused do like to let something to be recorded. Also class teacher's note (Mrs. Rituparna Chaki Ghosh) and Mr. Sagar Sengupta note regarding this incident (as initially they listen to the incident from complainant and accused as well) have to be collected and all these reports will be used for further investigation.
7. One e-mail address has to be formulated for further communication for all related persons related with this issue.

Meeting adjourned at 3:15 pm.
