

SUMMARY REPORT: INDUCTION PROGRAM SCHEDULE FOR BPHARM 1st YEAR 1st SEMESTER, 2020

The Induction program for B. Pharm 1st Year 1st Semester batch 2020 was conducted from 4th November, 2020 to 11th November, 2020 at Dr. B.C. Roy College of Pharmacy and Allied Health sciences through online mode due to pandemic situation. The program comprise of overall introduction to induction program, distribution of mentors and virtual introduction to institute facilities, E-Cell Program, Information about localities, MAR score, MOOCS Courses, Technical Program: Talk by prominent expert from industry, Yoga and fitness session, Social activity/ Webinar on stress management, Universal Human Values, Creative Arts: visual arts or performing arts/Literary activity, Interaction and closing ceremony. It was a successful event with active participation from all first- year students. Three students were selected as promosing inductee for the batch on the basis of theor response in the entire induction program.

The induction program was designed to allow students to be acclimatized to the institute and its activities. It is expected that the new entrants coming from diverse thoughts, backgrounds and preparations adjust to the new environment and inculcate in them the philosophy of the institution with a sense of larger purpose. It is intended to make the students feel comfortable in their new environment, open them up, set a healthy daily routine, create bonding in the batch as well as between faculty and students, develop awareness, sensitivity and understanding of the self, people around them, society at large, and nature.

Brief description of the induction program

- 1. Introduction to the induction program and mentor introduction.
- The students were formally introduced to the induction program ny Director and Principal, BCRCP.

- 2. Physical Activity:

- Then students were shown video presentations relating to major pharma research projects, manufacturing of formulations, role of regulatory agencies, facts relating the pharmaceutical field.
- b) Resource Person: Dr. Rudra Acharya, Consultant Psychiatrist, Medical College Hospital, Kolkata & Mrs. Debarati Acharya, Clinical Psychiatrist, Senior Counselor, IIT Kharagpur.
- A seminar on stress management was also held for students in order to help them fight the stress due to the present pandemic situation jointly with Brio Bliss Life Science Pvt. Ltd.
- 6. Visits to Local Area:
- Since it is a virtual program, students were given a glimpse about the local area through photographs and brief description of the places.
- They were also given a virtual tour of the different departments and area of the college in order to familiarize them to the institute.
- 7. Social activities:
- Students were given an online presentation of the social activities carried out in the institute.
- Several interactive sessions were held to put forward those situations as to their action as and role in society.
- 8. E-cell program
- Students were given an online presentation on the E-cell activities of the institute.








