Entrepreneurship development cell BCRCP - A report

An Entrepreneurship Development Cell was set up to foster E-cell activities in the institute in association with National Entrepreneurship Network. An MoU agreement was approved with the National Entrepreneurship Network (NEN) in collaboration with the Wadhvani Foundation for the term of 1st April 2016 to 31st March 2019. Dr. Indrani Bhattacharyya along with Mr. Sagar Sengupta and Mr. Prasun Moitra (In-charge of separate fund maintenance) and a committee of students was formed. Initial leaders were Mr. Sagar Sengupta and Mr. Avik Saha led by Dr. Indrani Bhattacharyya. Ms. Tania Sadhu and Mr. Sujit Nayek were chosen as student leaders.

The initiation of training of students was led by faculties of Wadhvani Foundation, Bangalore for the development of the idea of Entrepreneurship.

Training

The training was divided into two phases.

Phase-I – In this phase students were informed about the idea, objective of entrepreneurship, and development of project report, which were subjected for 3rd - year students. A separate online class was included in the regular class routine per week. At the end of the program, students were supposed to submit a successful project report including population target, area of the market, market size and initial investment, etc.

Phase-II – In the next phase, the selected students chosen by the NEN – Wadhvani foundation were further trained for the development of a pilot project and exhibition of the product or service. The scale-up process was also instructed.



A MCQ-based selection method was carried on for choosing the interested students for Phase I followed by Phase II.

Aswathama Repellent System – project submitted to Wadhvani foundation

Every year 30 tons of rice, 10 tons of wheat, 5 tons of barley etc. are being destroyed by elephants in North East India alone. 50-60 elephants and 100-125 men also lose their lives in these conflicts. The traditional way of dealing these conflicts are dangerous for both humans and elephants as well as expensive. So our team of 4 came up with a solution for farmers in elephant prone areas without harming this giant creature which is both cost effective and easy to use.



Our system is made up of 3 layers of security ---

1. The barrier
2. The sprinkler and alarm system
3. The smoke bombs

1 The barrier: We'll surround the farming area with a fence which will have a volatile substance that is intolerable by the elephant because they have a very keen olfactory sense and won't go near the fenced areas. This is quite cheap in comparison to electric fencing which is currently in use.

2 The sprinkler : If the elephants still enters the field, we'll have a alarm system with IR sensors which will trigger the alarm and alert everyone of eminent danger.

Not only will that it automatically activate the sprinklers which have chemical components intolerable to elephants.

IR sensor which will trigger the alarm

3 The smoke bombs : Our team has developed a special smoke bomb which is very effective against elephants because it is practically harmless to humans and it can be made from regular chemicals of farm. So it is cost efficient.
