Bootcamp

Dr. B. C. Roy College of Pharmacy and Allied Health Sciences organized a 2-days workshop named **‘Bootcamp on Molecule 2 Medicine: An Academic-Industry Bridge Program for being Industry Ready’** on 19th – 20th April 2022. The workshop was conducted by Mr. Bedadyuti Chakraborty, Director-RxCella and visiting scientist of Dr. Reddy’s Institute of Life Sciences. 45 students of Dr. B. C. Roy College of Pharmacy and Allied Health Sciences were selected from the final years of B. Pharm. And M. Pharm. courses to participate in this workshop based on their academic records.
